This internationally circulated journal, now in its 70th year of publication, is the English translation of the Russian-language journal *Mezhdunarodnaia zhizn*, which is published by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation. The editorial board of the source journal is traditionally headed by the Russian foreign minister, while contributors are primarily high-ranking diplomats and leading Russian international relations experts and scholars. As such, *International Affairs* is a vital primary source for anyone interested in studying and analyzing Russia's foreign policy, worldview, and approaches to security and international development.

Published in English by East View, *International Affairs* sheds light on:

- Russia's foreign policy and diplomacy
- Russia's approach to international relations, international organizations, and relations with foreign countries
